



Paid Internship available for 2026-2027 academic year

Catholic Campaign for Human Development Archdiocese of Baltimore

The Catholic Campaign for Human Development is the domestic anti-poverty, social justice program of the U.S. Catholic Bishops. Its mission is to address the root causes of poverty in America through promotion and support of community-controlled, self-help organizations and through transformative education. CCHD accomplishes this mission by (1) collecting and allocating funding to projects that address the root causes of poverty through institutional change efforts and (2) through its education activities for parishes and the Catholic Community.

This stipend-provided (academic) year-long internship is available for individuals to gain experience working with and on behalf of the poor through the CCHD archdiocesan office. Opportunities include: learning about the grant allocation process, development of promotional materials, assisting with parish events focused on the Catholic Social Teaching, connecting with Catholics to promote the issue of social justice.

Time Commitment: 12 hours a week for 24 weeks to be completed between Fall 2026 to Spring 2027.

Stipend Provided: \$20 per hour
